

# Togouchi Kiwami

## Product short description:

Produced from a blend of malt and grain whiskies, it contains nearly 40% malted barley and is aged a minimum of 9 years in oak barrels. The nose is intense, with sweet spices and yellow fruits. The palate is fresh and dry, with spices and citrus fruits. The finish is lively, with spices, citrus fruits, peat and smoky notes.

**About the Distillery:** founded in 1918, Chugoku Jojo brewery is located in Hiroshima area. Producer of liqueurs, sake and shochu, they started in 1990 the production of whisky by creating the "Togouchi" range. Their range is marked by great finesse and precision with aging in a single location, a 361 meter long tunnel dug in 1970. Ideal maturing conditions with a constant temperature of 14°C and a humidity of 80%, allowing slow extraction of aromas.
