About the brewery: Setou Shuzo was founded under the name Maruhei Masamune in 1789 by Tajibei Setou. He set up his factory in Shiotacho, Saga Prefecture. From 1920 their sake became ultra-known in the region, especially the sake Azumacho, whose name was given by the Japanese Prime Minister himself, Mr. Takashi Hara! In 1929, Setou Shuzo became the official sake supplier to the Imperial Palace in Showa era. Setou Shuzo's sakes are all very rich, with a really high Kasubuai, the percentage of Kasu remaining after filtration.

Tasting tips: to be served both afor aperitif and during the meal. Easy to pair with many preparations including izakaya-style dishes. To discover at different temperatures, from fresh to room temperature.
